# Call for Projects

### Enter your Project

Did you recently implement a supply chain project for the improvement of your procurement and logistics processes, or do you have a project still running?

Register your project for participation in the Supply Chain Award-Project of the Year 2011. We count on you. With your participation you will provide an important contribution to the further professionalization and recognition of the supply chain function. And you will grant your project and your team the extra attention they deserve.

### A Stimulus for all Organizations

With the Supply Chain Award-Project of the Year, VIB and PICS aim to bring supply chain projects under the attention of management and executives in Belgian companies and government organizations. It should stimulate them to invest more in projects that improve the efficiency of their procurement and supply chain processes.

### 2 Award Categories

The award categories include a SC Award for Large Enterprises (LE) and a SC Award for Small and Medium Enterprises (SME). A separate jury is installed for each category, thus facilitating the selection procedure and ensuring full attention to the specific aspects and environment of both categories.

### Your Project deserves a Platform

As a finalist in the Supply Chain Award-Project of the Year 2011 your project will gain full attention through your presentation at the Gala Award Event on the 8<sup>th</sup> of December 2011 at the ICC in Ghent.

Thanks to the cooperation between VIB and PICS this is an event on national level. Last year's edition was attended by over 600 delegates.

Moreover, as a winner, you can compete in the European Award for Supply Chain Excellence, organized by ELA (European Logistics Association). This European competition is a champions league, only accessible to winners of national awards from associations affiliated to ELA (such as VIB)

## CONDITIONS

### Who can enter a project?

- The Supply Chain Award-Project of the Year is open for every company domiciled in Belgium.
- Consultant companies and software providers can only enter a project through, or together with, the client where the project was implemented.
- Logistics service providers can enter a project solely, if it concerns an optimization of their internal supply chain, or together with the client where the project was implemented.
- Winners of last year's Awards cannot compete this year.

### Which companies are considered to be SME's

The category of Small and Medium Enterprises is made up of all enterprises which employ less than 100 persons or enterprises that employ less than 250 persons and have a yearly turnover of less than 50 million euro. These standards are applied to the entire group to which an enterprise belongs.

### Which projects can be entered?

- The project should include more than one aspect of procurement, logistics and/or supply chain management such as sourcing, SRM, CLM, stock management, production planning, materials management, distribution, transport, warehousing, inbound logistics, added value logistics etc
- The project should already be implemented for the greater part and have delivered proven and measurable results.

### Which criteria will be used to assess the projects?

The projects will be assessed on their **contribution to the total supply chain process**, their degree of **innovation and their added value related to the company's turnover**. Innovation in technology, sys-

tems and processes is related to the average degree of innovation of the sector to which the company belongs. Other criteria are **the degree in which the supply chain can anticipate in a flexible way to changes and demands from the market**, the clarity of the initial problem, the change management and the measurability and evaluation of the results.

### How will the selection take place?

Project files can be submitted until the 10<sup>th</sup> of July 2011. Two separate jury's will be installed for each Award Category (SME's and Large Enterprises). Both jury's will follow an identical selection procedure. The jury's select the finalists by evaluating the project files. The finalists receive a written confirmation of their selection.

Then the jury members audit the finalists' projects during an in-company visit. Finally the finalists have to present their project to their respective jury and receive feedback. Based on the evaluation of the project file, the audit and the preview presentation, the winners of both categories will be selected. Members of the jury cannot be contacted concerning their decision.

### Disclosure of the winner

The winners of the Supply Chain Awards-Project of the Year 2011 will be announced at the Gala Award Event on the 8<sup>th</sup> of December 2011 at the ICC in Ghent. During this event the finalists present their project to the audience. This audience also selects a winner for the Prize of the Audience.
